Public Health Courses

Post Acceptance into Public Health Program: Pre-Public Health Requirements

Formal acceptance into the Public Health program requires the following at minimum:

- Successful completion of ALL required prerequisite public health courses with a grade of "B-" or higher.
- Overall GPA of at least 3.0
- A science GPA of at least 2.75
- No more than one failure in a science course
- Pre-Public Health students should direct any questions about the process for formal acceptance into the Public Health program to their undergraduate advisor in the College of Arts and Sciences.

B.P.H. students must earn a minimum of "C+" as a final course grade in all public health courses. A final grade below a C+ will require the student to repeat the course to successfully complete all requirements of the public health curriculum plan. A final grade below a "C+" may impact a student's academic progression in the public health program. Any grade involving a numerical fraction is NOT rounded up at the end of the semester in the final course grade.
