One student did not meet the standard. Of the four (4) remaining students, twenty percent $(20 \%)$ met the standard and sixty percent ( $60 \%$ ) exceeded the standard which means that eighty percent ( $80 \%$ ) of the students scored at or above the standard. The one student who did not meet the standard was given remediation and allowed to redo the assignment to reach a score that met or exceeded the standard.

Twenty-five percent ( $25 \%$ ) of the students approached the standard, twelve percent ( $12 \%$ ) met the standard and sixty-three ( $63 \%$ ) exceeded the standard which means that seventy-five percent ( $75 \%$ ) of the students scored at or above the standard. The two students who did not meet the standard were given remediation and allowed to redo the assignment to reach a score that met or exceeded the standard.

These results indicate that the performance of the students have met the competencies identified in the components of NELP standard 2.
