Pre-Acceptance into Part-time Pre-licensure BSN Program: Prerequisite Requirements

- Pre-Nursing students for the **Part-time** program enter through the **School of Professional Studies (SPS)** to complete general education and prerequisite courses prior to formal acceptance into the Part-time BSN program in the School of Nursing and Health Professions (NHP). Students who have completed all prerequisites at another institution may apply for direct admission into NHP for the Part-time BSN program.
- All general education and nursing prerequisite course requirements listed below MUST be successfully completed before starting the Nursing Program, except SNHP 220, which may be taken after acceptance into the program.
- Early in the final semester of general education and prerequisite courses, students submit a formal application to the specific Nursing program. The Part-time Nursing program admits into the program once per year.

Admission criteria for formal acceptance into NHP health profession programs

Formal acceptance into the Nursing program requires the following at minimum:

- Successful completion of ALL required prerequisite nursing courses with a grade of "B-" or higher.
- Overall GPA of at least 3.0
- A science GPA of at least 2.75
- No more than one failure in a science course
- Satisfactory score on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)
- Pre-licensure BSN students should direct any questions about the process for formal acceptance into the Nursing program to their undergraduate advisor in the School of Professional Studies or NHP.
